## PROFESSIONAL BUSINESS INTERNSHIP FOR TWO RUSSIANS FROM TULA

Two senior executives from Tula, Russia arrived in the Capital Region on Sunday, June 24 to participate in a two-week business internship provided by the sister-city organization, the Albany-Tula Alliance.

Olesya Gulevskaya, finance director for a large digital marketing company in Tula called Ingate and Sergey Torin, Director of PPP Development Department at the JSC Tula Region Development Corporation, were chosen by the ATA Business Committee to participate in classes,



lectures and meetings in an effort to bolster citizen-to-citizen diplomatic relations between cultures. The candidates spent their first four days at the Holiday Inn on Wolf Road attending the *Basic Economic Development Course* learning about the strategies and policies for the international trade of products and services.

"This was a very useful and powerful experience for me," said Torin. "I am incredibly grateful to the Alliance for this opportunity."

"The knowledge I gained during this course helped to strengthen my understanding of business practices in the U.S.," said Gulevskaya.

ATA Chair, David Smith agreed. He emphasized that the mission of the ATA is to strengthen bonds between people and institutions in the Tula and Capital Region and that opportunities like this help.
